

26th edition of BIB moves place

AFTER 50 years, the prestigious competition and exhibition of book illustrations for children has moved to another venue.

The Biennial of Illustrations Bratislava (**BIB**) in its 26th year has already given the main award, the Grand Prix **BIB** - to young Dutch illustrator, Ludwig Volbeda. His illustrations in the book combine the narrative of a visual story with imaginative artistic language, the head of the nine-member international jury, Yukiko Hiromatsu, told the TASR newswire on September 8. The jury conferred for four days, and then decided on the ten statutory prizes, Golden Apples, for the most outstanding illustrators for children. For the first time, the ensuing exhibition will not take place in the House of Arts in SNP Square but instead it has been moved to the headquarters of the Slovak National Museum on the Vajanského nábrežie embankment.

It lasts until the end of October.
